Bishop Watterson Athletic Hall of Fame

Two of our own will be inducted into the Bishop Watterson Athletic Hall of Fame on August 28th.

Kathleen A. Bryant

July 25, 1962- December 8, 2017

Kathy was a 1980 graduate of Bishop Watterson High School where she was a state champion in track. She attended the University of Tennessee on a track & field scholarship where she was an individual national collegiate champion in the 5000 meter run as part of the Tennessee team that won the national championship. In all, she was an individual All-American 7 times in track & cross country, and was a member of the US team to the World Cross Country Championships. She was a participant in the Olympic Trials in Indianapolis in 1988 in the 10,000 meter run.

On August 26, 2022 Kathy will be inducted into the Bishop Watterson Athletic Hall of Fame. To this day Kathy's records have not been broken at Watterson.

Her mother Patty Bryant and sister Karen(Rich) Finn are beyond proud!!

Francis Doyle

Past President 2010

Francis played football for the Eagles from 1958-1961. He was named MVP for the 1961 season and selected for all league CCL(Central Catholic League) honors.

Francis is known as "Mr. Bishop Watterson Football." He is recognized as their football historian and also maintains a database with detailed results of all the games played along with various statistical information. He was the statistician from 2006-2018 keeping play by play results for the coaches as well providing this information to the local papers for reporting.

He is also the author of an article posted on Watterson's website that details the intense rivalry between Watterson and St. Francis De Sales entitled "The Game."

His wife Hilda & daughters, Stephanie & Heather, son-in-law Chris and his grandchildren Finnian and Eva are so very proud of Francis.

If you aren't doing anything on Friday, August 26 come to the opening Watterson football game against Dublin Scioto at Ohio Dominican University's football stadium. The induction ceremony will take place at half time. Hopefully you can make it out as we proudly watch our own Shamrock Club members be inducted into a place they so deserve and rightly earned.




