Secondly, because our Liquor license and building insurance are based on us being a member's only club we will only allow current members to order/purchase alcoholic beverages in the Club and on the grounds. You will be asked to show your current membership card to purchase alcohol. Guests are still permitted to attend events but, a member must buy their drinks for them or they can purchase a membership. All memberships purchased/renewed in the month of December will be good through December 31, 2024. This policy will be enforced for all dart, corn hole and horseshoe leagues as well as concerts. I know there will be many questions about this policy, so please reach out to one of the Officers, Executive Directors or POC members. Please be patient with the staff.

Chaplain's Comments



December is upon us, and the inescapable presence of the coming holiday season is everywhere among us: Christmas Trees, Santa Clause, Suzy Snowflake and other purely secular manifestations of a secular culture that has almost eclipsed the

religious meaning of Christmas. That's what we are faced with, and on the positive side, the commercialization of the Christmas Season also means that even the secular culture recognizes that this month is something special.

The beginning of the Liturgical Year in Advent yanks us back to the Christian meaning of this time. Advent - a term that means 'coming.' It's the Church's remembrance of the 4000 years the Chosen People waited for the coming of the promised Messiah. In the early Church, Advent looked forward to the Second Coming of Christ at the end of time. One of the chief promoters of the Christmas Creche was St. Francis of Assisi, whose poverty witness moved him to focus attention on the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph – very simple and even poor people, who followed the will of God by welcoming the Messiah, and yet appeared to all the rest of the world to be nobodys from nowhere. The Jews were expecting a powerful and charismatic leader who would restore the lost fortunes of the Jewish people. However, Jesus was his own type of Messiah. The humble

Perhaps the best we can do in this busy season is to take time during each day to remember WHO and WHAT this whole season is all about. And In this way, we can't help but welcome Christ in the present moment!

Day Membership Policy at the Pub

We recently reached out and received clarification from the Ohio Department of Liquor Control regarding our day membership policy at the pub. Their response was, "The D-4 statute requires "yearly dues." Due to this, the DOLC does not believe that the D-4 can have daily memberships. Also, if a "daily" dues payment is allowed this would make you equivalent to any other retail permit holder, who doesn't have to limit their sales to members. If you would like to apply, nothing would prohibit you from holding a D-1-2-3 or a D-5 permit. Also, you must maintain their roster of members to submit to the Division upon request."

Therefore, while non-member guests cannot start a tab, pay with cash, or in any way purchase alcohol, they are more than welcome to purchase a yearly membership. The easiest way is through the purchase of a pub membership because that membership level does not require board approval. Obviously we would prefer that folks join as Senior, General, or Family members but they would have to wait for Board approval before enjoying pub patron benefits.

How will this look at the Pub?

- Non-member guests can purchase a Pub Membership directly from staff or through the website.
- We will have a New Pub Member roster behind the bar for those who want to join in person. They simply have to enter their name, address, email and phone number and that's it, they're a member of the Club!
- We will maintain a current list of members behind the bar for staff reference.

What about facility rentals?

- Only club members can rent the club.
- If they opt for a host tab guests do not have to have a yearly membership because they are not directly purchasing alcohol.
- If the event is a cash bar, a flat Pub Membership fee (undetermined to date) will be added to their contract and rental fee structure and guests will have to sign the Membership roster.

We will be working through the sure-to-be million variations of the above scenarios and are asking for your patience, help, and great ideas to make sure we're in compliance.
