If you ask me, February is the worst month of the year. By this time, we're all sick and tired of the cold and the snow and are looking forward to March when the first hints of Spring appear. February is the shortest month, and it's also the most difficult to get through. However, there are some good things

occurring in February.

Ash Wednesday! The beginning of Lent begins this year is on February 22. This annual time of penance and mortification provides all of us the opportunity of spiritual growth by observing the traditional penitential practices of Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. All Catholics are urged to observe Ash Wednesday and Good Friday as days of fast and abstinence from the flesh of warm-blooded animals. Catholics are also urged to abstain from flesh meat on all the Fridays of Lent. However, if you have reached the age of 59, you are no longer bound by the laws of fast: one full meal and two lesser meals that don't equal a full meal. However, if you want to fast, do it!

Valentines Day! This comes on February 14, and provides all of us a chance to send Valentines not only to our wives, husbands and sweet hearts, but to all of those we love. Cards, candy and sweets are good gifts if we are so inclined, and we're lucky it falls before Ash Wednesday, when a lot of people give up candy and other treats as acts of penance and mortification. Most of us do not like penance and mortification, but we all need it from time to time and Lent provides us with a golden opportunity to practice the above mentioned penitential practices. It is to be hoped that these practices help us to make room for God by refraining from indulging ourselves. That's the reason for Lent. As Jesus went into the desert to fast and pray, we are asked to observe penitential practices in imitation of the time Jesus spent in fasting and prayer.

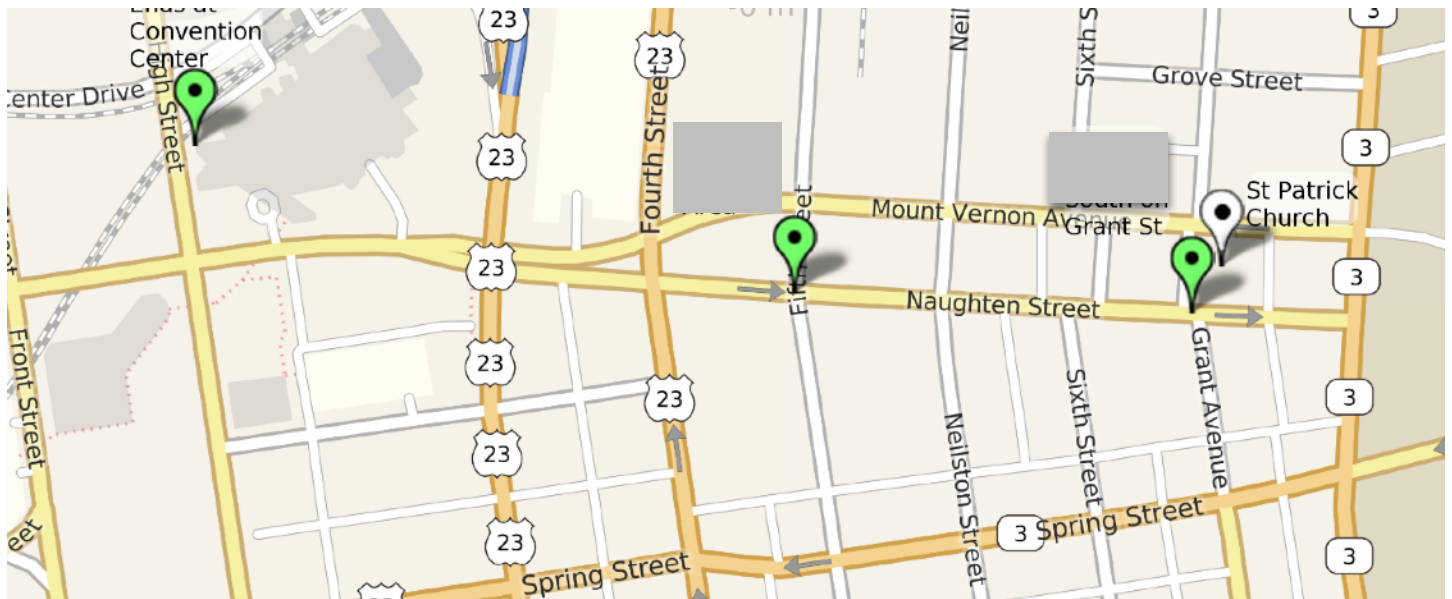

St. Patrick’s Day Procession to Mass

The Procession to Mass will form at 8:45am at the corner of Naghten Street and Neilston Street. It is suggested that all drivers of passenger vehicles that are participating in the Procession, drop people off at Naghten and Neilston Streets, then proceed to the Convention Center Parking Garage on Nationwide Blvd, then either walk back to the staging area or take the BEAT Shuttle Bus back to the Staging Area. The BEAT Shuttle Bus will be making runs from 8:00am until 9:15am. The cost for the BEAT shuttle is \$1.00 per person plus the purchase or display of the 2023 Parade Badge.

The Procession will step off at 9:00am and go east on Naghten Street to St. Patrick’s Church. Mass will be celebrated at 9:30am.

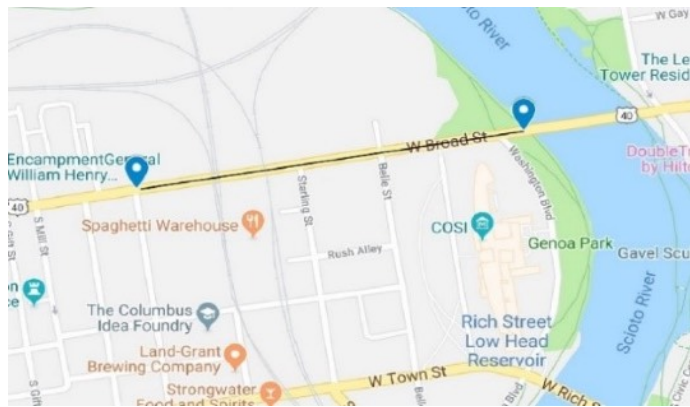

Parade Staging

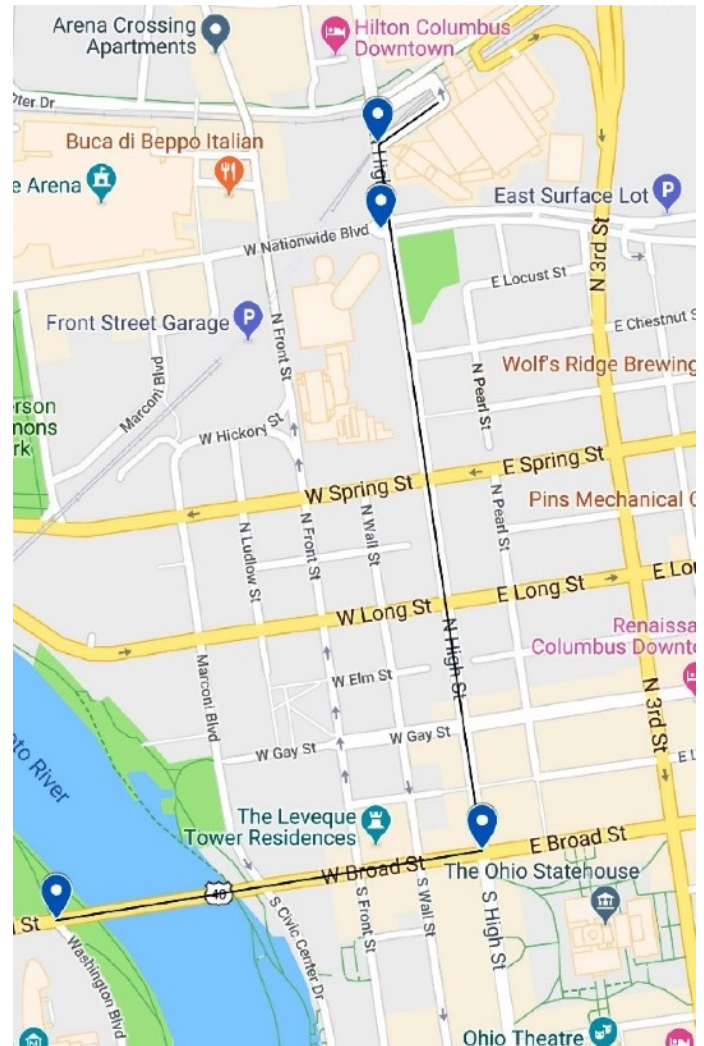

The Shamrock Club of Columbus has been selected, once again, to host the 15th Annual **Mark Dempsey Memorial International Irish Triathlon**, right here at the Shamrock Club, on **Saturday, February 18, 2023**, *any time between 12 p.m. and 3 p.m.* (or later if we want). This contest has been sanctioned by the International Olympic Committee, FIFA, USGA, NASCAR, WWE and several SEC referees. The triathlon events are darts (inside), cornhole and horseshoes (outside).

Triathletes may compete as many times as they pay. Entry fee is \$5 per round, which includes day membership for non-members. Leaders will be posted as scores are reported. The Champion will be immortalized on the **Dempsey Cup** trophy—the most coveted award in all sports. Then there is the new annual consolation prize with the **Susan S. Berkemer Sportsmanship Award**—because you're so pathetic at this Susan would feel bad for you.

Any triathlete wearing gloves for any event must wear the same pair of gloves for all three events. One bonus point deduction will be awarded per event for triathletes playing in shorts, kilts, flip-flops, belly shirts, etc. No leggings or long coats are allowed (The Daughters of Erin provision).

Triathlon Champion will be determined by total low number of throws in 301 darts (single in/single out), 11-point horseshoes and 21-point cornhole (no exact-out).
