

### **Treasurer's Report**


I hope that this report finds everyone healthy and in good Irish spirit.

### **Cleveland and the Civil War**



The History Press has recently published a new book entitled *Cleveland and the Civil War*. Cleveland and Cuyahoga County sent more than 9,000 troops to war - more than 1,700 never returned. It includes information regarding Cleveland's Hibernian Guards and its hero Thomas Francis Galwey and the postwar Fenian invasions of Canada, which included many Irish Civil War Union veterans. The author is Professor W. Dennis Keating of Cleveland State University. Professor Keating is also a member and past president of the Cleveland Civil War Roundtable.
