Horsing Around

No other month contains all the beauty and joy of May. April showers brings May flowers. We bring flowers of the fairest to crown Mother Mary. Our own saintly mothers are honored on Mother's Day. Graduation marks the end of school and the beginning of summer break. In my own family we begin "cake season" with many birthdays, including my twin brother's. Perhaps no other celebration equals the Kentucky Derby. For many years, a good friend of mine ran a bus trip from Columbus to Louisville because he wanted others to enjoy what he called his Christmas. Early on, I made the mistake of asking him what day the Derby was on, expecting him to give me the date. Instead, he told me, "The first Saturday in May, the same fecking day it has been for 137 years!" I should have been more specific. Regardless, I have had the good fortune to attend several races and each one has its memories. Friends from the Club have also joined the trip. You may recognize a couple people in the pictures below.

This year, I am going with that same friend to Ireland, and we hope to see the Galway Races, perhaps the Irish equivalent of the Derby. Or maybe due to the many Scotch-Irish settlers in Kentucky, it was the model for the Derby. We shall see, but the first week of August promises to be just as grand as Churchill Downs and "the most exciting two minutes in sports." Wherever you go, in my humble opinion, there is no more exciting moment in sports than when the race announcer says those thrilling words, "And DOWN THE STRETCH they come." Everyone is on their feet with anticipation, and hope hovers in the air as spectators clutch "the winning ticket." Much like Mary Kate Danaher as she waited to see who would grab her bonnet at the finish line during the Innisfree Derby.

As I head down the stretch, I am reminded how Jim O'Connor could always tie anything to a bit of Irish trivia. When speaking of the Kentucky Derby, he told me about Shergar, the 1981 Irish Derby winner from County Kildare. In February 1983, Shergar was stolen from a stud farm. The thieves demanded £2 million for his return. The ransom was never paid, and horse was never returned. Years later, an informant said that the horse was taken by the Provisional IRA to raise money for guns. Soon after the kidnapping he said Shergar damaged his leg and was shot by the gang. His remains were supposedly disposed of somewhere in County Leitrim. (Ask one of the ROMEO's what it's like searching for a dead horse. I shared that story with them one morning at breakfast, but that's a horse of a different color.) The IRA has never admitted any role in the theft.

I've crossed the finish line and maybe a few others, but I hope you join the Ladies Ancient Order of Hibernians for their Derby Party. I guarantee there won't be any long faces.
